The Fair & Impartial Policing® (FIP) 1-Day Refresher/Booster Train-the-Trainer Course July 27, 2020 St. Joseph, MO

The **FIP® Refresher Course** is designed for teams of agency trainers who have previously attended an FIP Train-the-Trainer course. During this 6-hour course, attendees will review the key principles of FIP, be introduced to the new-and-improved Patrol Officer and Supervisor curricula, and discuss implementation tips and issues. The **FIP® Booster Training of Trainers** course is a 2-hour course that will enable agency instructors to implement the NEW FIP® 4- hour Booster Training. Attendees will have opportunities to practice the curricula.

The **2020 Patrol and Supervisor FIP Curricula** maintain the key content of the original curricula, but include changes that reflect input from local FIP trainers across North America, updated research, new videos, and new exercises. Attendees will receive 2020 FIP binders and be provided with access to new web-based resources.

Eligibility: You must have previously completed a certified FIP® Train-the-Trainer course and be currently employed by a law enforcement agency or training academy that is committed to training the FIP curricula following the Refresher. At least two trainers, from each agency, should attend since the FIP curricula are team-taught.

FIP National Instructors represent local, county, state, and university police, and bring practical, “street-wise” applications for law enforcement.
