## The Fair & Impartial Policing® (FIP) Refresher Train-the-Trainer Course March 26, 2019 Troy, MI

The FIP® Refresher Course is designed for teams of agency trainers who have previously attended an FIP Train-the-Trainer course. During this 1-day course, attendees will review the key principles of FIP, be introduced to the new-and-improved Patrol Officer and Supervisor curricula and discuss implementation tips and issues. Attendees will have opportunities to practice the curricula.

The **2018 Patrol and Supervisor FIP Curricula** maintain the key content of the original curricula but have enhancements that reflect input from local FIP trainers across North America and include new videos, PowerPoints, science and bias information. Attendees will receive 2018 FIP binders and be provided with access to new web-based resources.

**Eligibility:** You must have previously completed a certified FIP® Train-the-Trainer course and be currently employed by a law enforcement agency or training academy that is committed to training the FIP curricula following the Refresher. At least two trainers, from each agency, should attend since the FIP curricula are team-taught.

**FIP National Instructors represent local, county, state, and university police, and bring practical, “street-wise” applications for law enforcement.**
