

FAIR & IMPARTIAL POLICING



A 1-hour **Certification** course that will prepare trainers to deliver FIP's Law Enforcement Civilian training within their agency. Attendees will be introduced to training content that is tailored specifically to non-sworn personnel who support law enforcement agencies such as crime analysts, dispatchers, forensics, technology, administrative support staff, and any other civilian role. FIP's Law Enforcement Civilian course incorporates examples, exercises and scenarios that are appropriate for line-level and supervisory personnel.

Eligibility: You must have previously completed a certified FIP® Train-the-Trainer course or Recertification course and be currently employed by a law enforcement agency or training academy that is committed to training the FIP curricula. Your FIP training certification and agency license agreement must not be expired.

Licensing FIP Curriculum Materials: An FIP license agreement authorizes trainers to use FIP's copyrighted and trademarked materials. The LE Civilian certification will expire on the date noted in your agency's existing license agreement.

Note: Course registration must be completed within 72 hours of course date to ensure delivery of training materials.

FIP National Instructors are current or retired law enforcement, representing local, county, state, and university police.
